United people and processes

When organisations foreground effective teamwork through their technology they can see improvements in consistency, compliancy, and efficiency (with less switching between apps) as well as a reduction in incidental document duplication.

intranet?

What is an intranet?

From a technical perspective an intranet is a local or restricted communications network for sharing information, tools, and systems. From a business perspective an intranet represents possibility, possibility to unite not only information and tools, but people and departments, possibility to empower these employees by keeping resources, culture, and support at their fingertips, and possibility to turn these engaged employees into brand advocates and internal innovators.

An effective and modern intranet can improve employee engagement. Improved employee engagement in turn can provide higher productivity, improved employee retention, increased team morale, and fewer mistakes, supporting profitability.

What makes an intranet modern?

Legacy intranets, such as Classic SharePoint, often require a new page to complete tasks and coding expertise to implement changes. In comparison, modern intranets are mobile responsive, with real-time updates, in-page editing capabilities, seamless integration with other business applications, personalised search tools, and optimised list and library experiences. A modern intranet is easy to use, can be deployed in a matter of clicks, and can easily integrate additional third-party services and tools.

By cultivating an intranet that suits modern working styles and supports the integration of additional business tools, organisations can use their intranet seamlessly as part of a wider digital workspace. Intranet v Teams

Why do I even need an Intranet?

Tools such as email are great for communicating and they're familiar to users, so why change a winning formula?

Social Media





What makes a successful Intranet?

Know your culture

Integrate your business processes

By supporting and centralising these key processes, employees will use your intranet more frequently and effectively.



Plan your architecture

Encompassing your organisation into an intranet can seem daunting. This is why architecture planning is so important. By investing time early in your design process to architecture planning you can ensure that each department is supported within your intranet and ensure that metadata tagging and intelligent search is effectively configured.



Engage your employees

Ensuring that an intranet engages your employees is not a static task. Prior to building your intranet, ascertain your employees' wants and needs to inform your design. Post-deployment it is important to request feedback and monitor analytics to understand where training is required and where improvements can be made.



Keep sites consistent

Intranets strive to make information and resources easy to locate. A key method to achieve this is to promote consistency over sites and pages. Users can use pre-existing templates (or create their own) to help achieve this consistency. In addition to this, ownership should be assigned to sites, to ensure information is consistent and current.
